



- Applicant in the Mrs. division must be married as of the date of entry, and throughout the state and national competition.
- Applicant is and always has been a female and is at least 18 years of age as of the date of entry.
- Applicant will continue to be a person of good moral character, and understands the Idaho America Pageants Expectations: affirms that she has not committed and will not commit any act inconsistent with the highest standards of public morals and conventions or that will reflect unfavorably on the Pageant, its representatives, sponsors and/or licensees: that during her majority (18 years of age or older), she has not willingly appeared in provocative and sexually explicit photographs for any film, video, or publication prior to, during the state pageant, or during her reign as a state winner or national winner.
- Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen and a resident of the state of Idaho, or “Military Installation” in Idaho. Applicant is only permitted to enter one State Pageant per Pageant year, and must follow rules outlined above.
- Applicant agrees to look solely to the State Directors with respect to all matters relating to the State Pageant, including her application to enter the Idaho America Pageant, the preparation, rehearsal, performance, and selection process relating to the Idaho America Pageant, and all other matters relating to the Idaho America Pageant. Mrs. America, Inc. its Officers, Directors, Agents and Employees are not liable to Applicant to anything whatsoever in connection with the Idaho America Pageant.
- Applicant understands, and agrees to a zero tolerance for alcohol consumption, and/or being under the influence on pageant grounds (event center, conference room, interview room, backstage, etc.,) and during any portion of the Idaho America Pageant. Failure to abide will result in an automatic disqualification.
- Applicant will attend the National Pageant if selected as the winner at the Idaho America Pageant, and further abide by all the required services, rules, and regulations governing the National Pageant. Applicant is responsible to both Mrs. America and the Idaho America Pageant Directors in the event of non-compliance with the same.
- Applicant may have a modeling, personal management and/or agency contract - however, does not include, authorize, or permit the use of the name of “Mrs. America Pageant” or “Idaho America Pageants,” or any title designation or reference with respect to the Pageant in any manner. Applicant may not have any commercial tie-up or endorsement agreement or commitment or any kind whatsoever. Applicant agrees to be bound by the rules, regulations and the Contestant Agreement required by Mrs. America, Inc.

- Idaho America Pageant Directors, at their discretion, may accept a qualified Contestant who has competed at the Mrs. America Pageant in non-consecutive years.
- A contestant may not participate as a contestant in another pageant for married women while holding a local, or state title in the Mrs. America system. Contestant will not enter or participate in any way, either directly, or indirectly, including as a contestant, judge, promoter, producer, manager, consultant or otherwise, in any other beauty pageant unless otherwise approved.
- Relative to State matters, the Directors shall have the final approval of wardrobe, appearances, press releases, coaching and hair and make-up providers. Winner agrees to support all sponsors; as directed by the Idaho America Pageant directors.
- Applicant hereby authorizes the use of any photos or video reproduction of the Applicant at the Idaho America State Pageant for promotional purposes.
- As consideration for this agreement, Contestant promises to pay the respective Idaho America Pageant entry fee, and understands that all payments are non-refundable.
- Failure of a contestant to abide by the rules above may result in disqualification and/or removal of the Idaho title at the discretion of the State Directors, subject to review by the National Pageant Grievance Committee.
- Comments, rankings, etc. from the Judges will not be made available to Contestants. Contestants will be provided with notes/feedback following the Idaho America Pageant.
- Crowned titleholders are not entitled to charging for any services during their reign. This includes work with organizations, + current Idaho America Pageant contestants i.e. coaching, practice, paperwork help.
- Idaho America Pageant directors will have full access to any and all official social media platforms.
